




VOLUME I – COVER SHEET

VOLUME II – TECHNICAL VOLUME



Volume II should address:

- Identification and significance of the problem or opportunity
- Phase I Technical Objectives
- Statement of Work
- Related Work
- Relationship of proposed work to future research or research and development
- Commercialization Strategy


Note, information regarding key personnel, subcontractors and consultants as well as facilities and equipment should be included within the Technical Volume as it relates to the work to be performed; however, full technical resumes/biographical information, letters of support, and detailed descriptions of facilities and equipment should be reserved for inclusion in Volume 5, Supporting Documents. The Technical Volume for the Army 21.C solicitation is Not To Exceed (NTE) 5 pages.



VOLUME V – SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS



- Volume V should include:
 - Contractor Certification Regarding Provision of Prohibited Video Surveillance and Telecommunications Services and Equipment (BAA Attachment 1)
 - > Foreign Ownership or Control Disclosure Addendum (BAA Attachment 2)
 - > Full technical resumes/biographical information of Key Personnel
 - > Letters of Support
 - > Detailed descriptions of facilities and equipment



VOLUME VI – FRAUD, WASTE AND ABUSE TRAINING



- The Fraud, Waste and Abuse (FWA) training is required for Phase I proposals.
- This training material can be found in the Volume 6 section of the proposal submission module in DSIP and must be thoroughly reviewed once per year.
- FWA training must be completed by one DSIP firm user with read/write access (Proposal Owner, Corporate Official or Firm Admin) on behalf of the firm.



SBIR/STTR PHASE I PROCESS



SOLICITATION TOPICS

Agencies describe R&D topics in solicitations at fixed time periods over the year announced on FBO



Small Businesses prepare short proposals. Unsolicited proposals are not accepted.

EVALUATION

Agencies evaluate based on technical merit, firm's qualifications, and commercial potential/benefit

Selection Notification within 90 days

PHASE I AWARD

Agencies make Phase I awards – contracts or grants.

Within 180 days











SBIR/STTR PHASE I PROCESS



SOLICITATION TOPICS

- Proposals are evaluated by several tiers of evaluators using the following criteria, which are published in the BAA:
 - ✓ Technical Feasibility Soundness, technical merit, and innovation of proposed approach and its incremental progress toward topic or subtopic solution (40%)
 - ✓ Qualifications of the firm and team to perform R&D and commercialize results -Strength of the Personnel & Facilities (30%)
 - ✓ Transition Potential Potential for commercial application government or private sector (30%)
- Each proposal is evaluated on its own merit and not evaluated against other proposals
- Evaluators complete source selection training and sign NDAs yearly; their evaluations of every proposal must address all criterion strengths and weaknesses and provide constructive comments to enable SBCs to submit better proposals in the future

Agencies make Phase I awards – contracts or grants.
